MULTI-DAY ISLAND TRIPS

Trips are structured to make the most of each day, combining fishing, exploring, and relaxed time around camp as conditions allow. Fish the surrounding fringing reefs for fresh catch-and-cook meals, walk remote beaches, and when weather permits, run the eastern side of Hinchinbrook Island to Zoe Bay for a hike and swim at Zoe Falls.

Minimum 4 days.



PRIVATE EXCLUSIVE TRIPS

1-3 Guests – Private trips only. Limited numbers allow a personalised experience and flexibility to shape each day around fishing, exploring, or a balanced mix of both. Access to reef, beach, and estuary environments is done using our Sportsman vessel, allowing us to move easily between locations as conditions change.



PRIMARY FOCUS: ISLAND FISHING & CATCH AND COOK

Fishing opportunities include mangrove jack, barramundi, coral trout, golden snapper, queenfish, trevally, and mackerel across reef and estuary systems. Oysters and mud crabs can also be collected and prepared as part of the daily catch and cook experience, adding another dimension to life on a remote tropical island.

LOCATION & ACCESS

Operating within the Hinchinbrook region of Tropical North Queensland, this multi-day island camp experience begins with a guided transfer from Cairns to the coastal township of Cardwell before travelling by boat to our remote island base.

With camp established on the island for the duration of the trip, each day unfolds around fishing, exploring, beach walks, and shared catch-and-cook meals, allowing guests to settle into the rhythm of island life in one of the most scenic coastal environments in Tropical North Queensland.

CAMP SETUP & ISLAND LIVING

- Fully established island camp for the duration of the trip
 - Comfortable tents with quality bedding provided
 - Cooking equipment and shared camp facilities supplied

Meals Included:

- Breakfast – fresh fruit, cereal, and coffee
- Lunch – prepared on the island or during daily outings
- Dinner – fresh local produce with catch-and-cook seafood where available
- Oysters and mud crabs can often be collected and prepared as part of the experience

This is a relaxed, hands-on style of remote island living with everything required supplied and set up for you.

GUIDE VESSEL

Access to the island provided using our 19ft Sportsman centre-console guide vessel, Designed for operating throughout the Hinchinbrook region.

- Private groups of 1-3 guests
- Used for daily fishing sessions and island exploration
- Access to fringing reefs, island beaches and nearby estuary waters including Missionary Bay

When conditions allow, we also visit Zoe Bay on Hinchinbrook Island for a guided walk and swim at Zoe Falls.

TRIP FORMAT / ITINERARY

Day 1 - Arrival & Island Setup

- Pick up Cairns Airport or CBD
- Transfer south to Cardwell (approx. 2 hrs)
 - Boat transfer to remote island camp
 - Set up camp and settle in
 - Afternoon fishing / beach exploring
- Dinner on the island – fresh local produce or catch and cook

Island Days

Early morning fishing session (reef / beach / estuary options)

- Return to camp for breakfast / relax
- Midday exploring, beach walks or island downtime
 - Optional oyster or mud crab collecting
 - Afternoon fishing session
- Evening catch and cook dinner on the island

Weather permitting:

- Day trip to Zoe Bay
- Guided walk to Zoe Falls on Hinchinbrook Island

Final Day

Morning beach session or island explore

- Pack down camp
- Boat transfer to Cardwell
- Transfer return to Cairns Airport or CBD

Trip Notes

Minimum 4 days (3 nights) typical

- Private trips only (1-3 guests)
- Flexible daily structure based on weather and conditions
- Mix of fringing reef, beach and estuary fishing environments
