

Karumba Gulf Barramundi Trips

MULTI-DAY KARUMBA TRIPS

Trips are structured to make the most of each day, with flexible daily planning based around tides and conditions across the Karumba region. Fishing sessions focus around productive river mouths and surrounding Gulf systems, with time to enjoy the relaxed pace of this remote northern town between sessions. Evenings are typically spent at the local pub and waterfront, with the Gulf's famous sunsets a highlight of the experience.



PRIVATE EXCLUSIVE TRIPS

1-5 Guests – Private trips only. Limited group sizes allow a personalised experience and flexibility to plan each day around conditions across the Karumba region. Fishing is conducted from our Sportsman and Barra Tracker guide boats, both fitted with LiveScope sonar, allowing access to productive river mouths and surrounding Gulf systems throughout the trip.



PRIMARY FOCUS: BARRAMUNDI FISHING

The primary focus of these trips is targeting barramundi across the tidal flats, coastal drains, river systems and surrounding Gulf country that make the Karumba region one of Australia's best barra fishing locations. These environments consistently produce quality fish, including metre-plus barramundi, with daily plans adjusted to make the most of conditions throughout the trip.

LOCATION & ACCESS

Operating from Karumba on the western edge of the Gulf of Carpentaria, this multi-day barramundi package begins with either flights into Normanton or overland travel across the Gulf country with the guide from the east coast.

Guests are based in comfortable local accommodation in Karumba for the duration of the trip, allowing efficient access to the boat launch for daily fishing sessions and the local pub for dinner each evening. Each day is structured around fishing sessions with relaxed time in town between outings, offering the opportunity to experience the unique pace and atmosphere of life in one of Australia's most remote barramundi destinations.

ACCOMMODATION & MEALS

Accommodation is provided in comfortable local Karumba lodging close to the boat ramp for efficient early starts and flexible afternoon sessions.

Meals Included:

- Breakfast – continental style with fruit, toast, cereal and coffee
- Lunch – Fresh made lunch provided daily during fishing
- Dinner – local pub meals, restaurant dining or takeaway depending on daily plans

Evenings are relaxed and social, with the Gulf's famous sunsets a highlight of the Karumba experience.

GUIDE BOATS

Fishing is conducted from our Sportsman centre-console and Barra Tracker guide boats, both fitted with LiveScope sonar and suited to operating throughout the Karumba region and surrounding Gulf systems.

- Private groups of 1-5 guests
- Sportsman – max 3 anglers
- Barra Tracker – max 2 anglers

These vessels allow flexible access across a wide range of productive Gulf barramundi environments throughout the trip.

TRIP FORMAT / ITINERARY

Day 1 - Arrival & Afternoon Session

Depart Cairns 630am overland travel with the guide

Arrival at Karumba accommodation 4pm

- **Settle in and prepare gear**
- **Dinner at the local pub Gulf with sunset on the waterfront**

Fishing Days

- **Early morning breakfast before departing for the day's fishing**
- **Usually a 6:30 am start depending on guests, tides and conditions**
 - **Full day fishing exploring the Normanton River and Gulf Coast**
 - **Lunch on the water provided by guides**
 - **Return to the ramp around 4:30-5:00 pm**
- **Afternoon beers, Gulf sunsets and evening meals at the local pub**
- **Relaxed evenings enjoying the atmosphere of Karumba and the Gulf**

Final Day

- **Early morning departure from Karumba (approx. 6:00 am)**
 - **Overland transfer returning to Cairns**
 - **Arrival Cairns approximately 4:00 pm**
